SACRAMENTAL PREPARATION

- The Pastor can have engaged couples watch *BELOVED* and reflect in their participant guides and then meet to discuss the content with him.
- Mentor Couples can watch *BELOVED* and discuss with engaged couples or have the engaged couples watch *BELOVED* on their own time and meet with mentor couples to discuss.
- A 1-day Pre-Cana setting can go through *The Mystery and Meaning of Marriage* sessions 1-6.
- A three-session (90 minutes each) Pre-Cana setting can cover two sessions of *BELOVED* each meeting.

LARGE GROUP PRESENTATION

- Pick the time and location for a 6-week study

DISCIPLESHIP GROUPS

PARISH WIDE STUDY

- Pick 6 weeks in the calendar for your Parish Wide Study

- Pick a weekend and use the pulpit pitch at the end of the masses to invite participation from all parishioners and encourage them to watch and discuss in their families and with friends
- Print business cards and do a reverse collection at the end of all the masses

MARRIAGE RETREAT

- Pick a weekend in the calendar for your marriage retreat with *BELOVED*.
