### What to tell your parishioners:

- The Gospels are fables written long after Jesus' public ministry, and they can't be trusted.
- The idea that Jesus is the son of God is a legend that grew after his death.
- Jesus was just a really good man. A guru of sorts.
- These are lies, and we must not fall for them.

The best evidence and scholarship tell a different story.

- The Gospels are biographies—and they were written by Matthew, Mark (who was a companion of Peter), Luke (a companion of Paul), and John.
- The prophecies were clear about Jesus.
- And Jesus was clear too – he is the son of God.
