
THE FORMED NEWSLETTER FOR PASTORS AND PARISH LEADERS



The month of November is a time to look back on the year and remember how the Lord has made himself present in our lives. Moreover, it is a time to reflect with gratitude on the gifts he has given us while looking forward to the ultimate gift of Christ himself in the Christmas season.

Coming from the Latin "adventus," meaning "a coming or approach," the season of Advent is the beginning of the Church's liturgical year. It is a time dedicated to preparing ourselves for Christ's Second Coming as we also remember the Nativity of Our Lord. This year, Advent begins on Sunday, December 3, and ends on Christmas Eve.

When reflecting on Advent, we might consider the "O" Antiphons—a series of antiphons sung during Evening Prayer from December 17 through Christmas Day—as a guide for our own approach to the season. These antiphons reference the Old Testament's hope for the coming messiah while also announcing the birth of Christ. Likewise, we can use this time to renew our own hope and trust in the Lord, allowing our spirits to be filled with the joy, peace, and love of God as we look forward to Christmas. As we renew our hope, FORMED's new series, *Rooted: Rediscover the Jesse Tree This Advent*, is a great way to dive into the Advent season and deepen our spiritual lives. This series examines Old Testament stories and reflects on how they can prepare us for the coming messiah in the same way that God prepared his people for the Nativity of Our Lord. Like the "O" Antiphons, each episode uses the words and stories of the Old Testament to herald the coming of Christ. Through this, we can prepare our hearts and minds for the Christmas season, understanding all the more how the Lord is inviting us to receive him with love and joy.

Drawing Closer to God this Advent

As the holidays approach, our families look forward to the coming of Christmas and the season of giving and joy. Yet this *looking forward* does not always translate to *preparing*. We might have all the decorations put out and the presents wrapped, but are the inside of our hearts as prepared as the outside of our homes or the gifts under the tree?



The season of Advent responds to the busyness we can find ourselves in before Christmas and gives us the opportunity to step back and prepare for the coming of Christ. It is a time to examine our hearts and reflect on how we can grow more in our relationship with God. In family life, it is especially a time to bring our family together in prayer and conversation about the Nativity of the Lord. Yet starting the conversation on Advent can be challenging. We might struggle with what to talk about, or how to teach our children in a way that is engaging and clear.

Enter *Drawing Closer to God*, FORMED's newest series dedicated to teaching young children about the Advent season through fun and creative means. In this series, children and families can journey through the Advent season and learn about different scenes from Scripture and Tradition through art and storytelling. With each episode, kids are challenged to prepare their hearts and minds for Christmas through sacrifice, prayer, charity, and joy.


Adventus: A Spiritual Pilgrimage
