THE VIRTUES OF ADVENT

In the time leading up to Christmas, the Advent wreath is often used to represent the virtues of hope, peace, love, and joy that we reflect on in the Advent season. As we pass through each week of Advent, we can contemplate the importance of each virtue and consider the ways that the Lord is calling us to grow in them. Through this, we prepare our hearts and minds for the spirit of rejoicing in the Christmas season.

Traditions like the Advent wreath have become a staple for families to introduce the preparatory nature of the season to their children. To go alongside this, FORMED is excited to offer *Drawing Closer to God*, a Catholic art show for kids. This series is dedicated to teaching young children about the Advent season and helping families “draw closer” to the Lord. Beginning with a lesson on the Advent wreath, each episode includes both creative storytelling and crafting. Children will follow along with Catholic art teacher Ms. Kim as she tells and illustrates the stories of the Annunciation, the journey to Bethlehem, the shepherds in the field, the Nativity, and more.

In each episode, Ms. Kim begins with a brief introduction to the story of the image she will be drawing. Each story captures and portrays the virtues of Advent in a way that challenges families to grow more in them. After praying a creative prayer, she gives step-by-step instructions on how to draw each picture so kids can follow along. As she colors in the image, Ms. Kim reflects on the story and invites families to prepare themselves in tangible and practical ways for the coming of Christ at Christmas.

As you help families prepare for Christmas, consider using *Drawing Closer to God* as an invitation for them to grow and learn about the stories of hope, peace, love, and joy that fill the Advent season.
